BBC EASTER BROADCASTING

The BBC will be broadcasting the Pope's *Urbi et Orbi* address from Rome on Easter Sunday on BBC1 at 11am (UK time).

In addition, the BBC's 39 Local Radio stations will be broadcasting **Cardinal Vincent Nichols's Easter Sunday Mass** at 8am.

You may also be interested in **The Passion in Plants**, broadcast on Radio 4 at 9.45am from Monday to Friday in Holy Week which is about the traditions of British wild plants associated with the events of Holy Week or **Meditations from a Monastery**, part of the Slow Radio series every night this week on Radio 3 at 10.45pm.
